The French novelist, Gustave Flaubert (1821-80) (amongst many others important in history) said, "Le bon Dieu est dans le detail", Which can mean "G-d is in the details"! You may have heard or seen the version, "The Devil is in the details" referring to a "catch hidden in the details".

What I have found interesting about this quote as I read **"The Holiness of Doubt"** by Rabbi Joshua Hoffman, current President of AJRCA (Academy for Jewish Religion, CA) the Yeshiva I attended, is its parallel to the Torah portion for February 17, Terumah, where we find there are no questions about the "details" of the sanctuary that was to be built in this Parasha.

You well know, it is our "job" as Jews to ask questions to clarify or learn more in depth about what is really happening here. The portion focuses on the individuals who built the portable **mishkan**, "from every person whose heart so moves them." This is the first chore the Israelites do together to "provide national duty in order to serve the divine."

It is no wonder then, that so many times have we said, that we are better collectively than individually, that we accomplish more, and are more effective when we work together to achieve a common goal. This is just one of many examples of when the Jewish people came to together to accomplish something great!

Our goal should be to continue this legacy of "collective unity" in every generation. May it be so! B'ezrat Hashem, with the help of G-d!
