This month we read **M'tzorah**. I cannot tell you how many times we have discussed **Lashon HaRah** (the Evil Tongue) since my arrival some 15 years ago. But I can tell you this, I have made mistakes in my speech and most likely you have too. We are human and this happens. It is not about what was said, but how both parties recover and move on from it.

The Parasha discusses in great detail about an individual's health appearance and what to do about it if there is a skin issue.
