
The 3-week mourning period which began in July (Tammuz) culminates this month on the **9th of Av** (**Tisha B'Av**, Monday, August 12 in the evening). This is called a "mini Yom Kippur" because we fast (all day), don't wear leather, sit low on the floor, and listen to lamentation poetry from

the past. This date in history is filled with calamity, catastrophes, and destruction for the Jewish people.

I ask you, "What's new"? As I have written in the last 2 articles, we are at a critical time here in the US and the world with anti-Semitism on the rise, and our homeland of Israel being surrounded and attacked. We are all struggling. What do we say and how do we combat what is going on?

I can remember many incidences in my life when I was down, had failed, was not sure what to do or who to turn to for help. You see, when we fail or feel beaten, to show who you really are and "what you are made of", we keep going! We "fight" on to "fail" or "succeed" another day. It's not what you do when it happens, it is the action you take after you fail or fall. It is how you pick yourself up and remind yourself, who you are, who your family is, and what your ultimate goals are. Then, after that, it is how you execute your game plan. How will you express your Jewishness during this time of change?

Here are some additional myths you might hear. (from <u>antisemitism.adl.org</u>):

Do you have an answer for each one?

- 1. **Jews have too much power.** (Jews are only .2% of the world's population and we do not seek domination of the world!)
- 2.**Jews are disloyal.** (One origin of this myth is the New Testament, Judas.)
- 3. **Jews are greedy.** (This is much more complicated, but shouldn't hard work be rewarded for everyone? This is a very harsh stereotype.)
- 4. **Jews killed Jesus.** (See Pope Paul VI, 1964 declaration)
- 5.Jews use Christian Blood for religious rituals (Blood Libel). Jewish law forbids the consumption of any blood, human or animal.
- 6.**The Holocaust didn't happen.** (We have all seen the proof and met survivors!)
- 7.From last month; Anti-Zionism or Criticism of Israel is never anti-Semitic. (It is ok to criticize a government but not destroy a people.)

Adon Olam, Master of the Universe, as Tisha B'Av comes and goes, allow us to be consoled, healed physically and spiritually, and be true to ourselves. Ultimately, allow us (Israel and Jews around the world) to be in a better and stronger position with hope and faith as we turn the corner towards the peace we hope will follow.

ACTIVE SHOOTER TRAINING

Will you know what to do if you find yourself in an active shooter situation? CBS will be hosting a free training to all congregants on Sunday, September 15 from 2:30 PM – 4:30 PM that will teach you the tools you need to:

- Avoid and escape from an active shooter
- Hide, barricade yourself, and stay calm
- Fight back to survive

The training will be hands-on and will include a video and question and answer component. We encourage everyone to take this training.

Note: the training date is tentative and pending approval from the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES).

ROSH HASHANAH LA'BEHEMOT

The middot *Tzar Ba'al Chayyim*, to avoid causing pain to animals, particularly domesticated animals; and, *Ohev et HaBriyot*, love and respect for all animals, outline how we are responsible for the care and treatment of domesticated and wild animals.

On Sunday, September 8 at 6:30 PM, the Confirmation Class will be leading the service to revive an age-old celebration for all G-d's creatures and the caregivers who support them – Rosh Hashanah La'Behemot.

Xime W. will be our special guest speaker and spiritual leader. Please celebrate this holiday, which has become so important to our congregation's young people. Even if you are not an animal caregiver, please join us to realize how animals provide for you more than you can imagine.

This is also the time when the students will sound the shofar, announcing the coming of the High Holy Days. After the service, enjoy a special oneg to pay respect for animals on this special day. This is the time for new beginnings and Teshuvah.


