THE CANTOR'S CORNER

We mark the 1^{st} evening of the month as the 50^{th} day since Passover. We have been counting the Omer since the 2^{nd} day of Passover.

Shavu'ot is the Festival of the Receiving of the Torah. When the Israelites left Egypt, just 7 weeks after departing from Egypt and reached Mount Sinai, they had

to make a decision. Accept or reject the platform that was put in front of them. (Deuteronomy 5:27) "We will do and we will hear (**Na'aseh V'Nishma**)." This is so unlike the human psyche. Usually, we want the details about what is being asked of us, then understand it, then maybe do it. But this time the Israelites after just a short time accepted what was put in front of them showing their "blind faith" in what the Source of Life was about to provide.

No one likes restrictions on their lives. We all have "Free Will" to do what we want. But certain actions have consequences as you well know. Here is the interesting thing about that situation. "Not only did each individual recognize the importance and beauty of the Torah, but to observe it, as well as being responsible for other Jews to do it as well". Who said, "we are not our Brothers/Sisters keepers?"

Adon Olam, Master of the Universe, may we be inspired and may we inspire the next generation to continue, as Ben Bag Bag in **Pirkei Avot** (morals/ethics of our Fathers, Chapter 5) said of the Torah, "turn it and turn it again, for everything is in it. Pour over it, and wax gray and old over it. Stir not from it for you can have no better rule than it".
