At the very end of April and the first day of May, we celebrate Israel's Independence Day, **Yom Ha'atsma'ut**. This year we mark the 77<sup>th</sup> year of the existence of the State of Israel. I am so proud to be Jewish and to be a Zionist. It wasn't until I went to Camp Tel Yehudah along the Delaware Gap in Barryville, NY, as a teen that I realized I was one.

My Mom was a member of Hadassah and that camp was designed for the youth of parents who supported Israel! What an awakening to everyone at camp being Jewish, Jewish music, learning Hebrew through the Ulpan program, communal living, history, learning leadership, and an introduction to life on a Kibbutz. Also, this month, we continue to count the Omer, enjoy Lag B'Omer (33<sup>rd</sup> day of the counting of the Omer, a respite amongst the 49 days of counting), and celebrate Yom Yerushalayim which commemorates the reunification of Jerusalem during the 6-Day War in 1967!

Also, at the end of May, we finish the Book of Leviticus, which included ideas about how we as Jews "should behave as individuals and as a society as well as affirm our faithfulness of worship to the Source of Life".

**Adon Olam**, Master of the Universe, may we inspire the next generation to continue purposeful living, recommit to the laws we can follow in the Torah, improve upon ourselves, and our leadership in the years to follow.
