THE CANTOR'S CORNER

Nahag Chadash...NEW DRIVER! Last month, I was listening to one of my favorite Pod-Caster's, Joel Chasnoff (www.joelchasnoff.com), the Israeli comedian originally from Chicago. The topic he was discussing was, "what it was like to drive in Israel!" For those of us who have been there...it is CRAZY!

First of all, one cannot even obtain a permit to drive until they are 16 years and 9 months. When a person becomes that age, they can take a class which they (or their parents) have to pay for out of their own pocket (about US \$1,500-\$2,000). That gives them about 30 hours of training, and then they can take the driving test, which most fail on the 1st attempt. If one is lucky to pass the first time, that person can drive by themselves during daylight hours, but must drive with an experienced driver of at least 5 years at night for 3 months.

Then comes the experience of actually driving in Israel. What should the driver do if a car is coming at them on a 2-lane road? What to do if they need to drive on the sidewalk? How to avoid hitting pedestrians? How not to knock over any e-bikes on a sidewalk? What if the street is blocked by a parked vehicle on a 2-way street? How does one safely maneuver and get around?




